

4 + 1 Program Application

Program Information

Students who are admitted to the 4+1 program may take four graduate level courses and double-count those credits toward both their bachelor's and their master's degrees. (MBA Accounting students may double-count two courses.) The rules of the program are as follows:

1. Students may apply to the 4+1 program when they have completed 75 undergraduate credits.
2. They may begin taking graduate courses when they have completed 90 credits (MBA, MSM, MSOL, MPsy) or when they have 11 courses left (MSE). See chart below for specific prerequisites.
3. A maximum of 12 credits can be double-counted for the bachelor's degree and master's degree for the MBA, MSM, MSOL, MPsy and MSE programs. (Six credits for MBA Accounting.)
4. Students will remain classified as undergraduates until they have completed all requirements for their bachelor's degree. Students must maintain academic standards stated below. If a student does not meet these requirements, he/she will be dismissed from the 4+1 program and lose the ability to double-count the credits. The student must then take the necessary courses to finish the undergraduate program.
